

Condos a twist on Bellarmine show house

The Bellarmine University Women's Council is sponsoring the 33rd Annual Designers' Show House today through Sept. 24 at The Park Grande, a new luxury condominium complex at 1604 Cherokee Road.

The show house will highlight two of the six 4,000-square-foot units in the complex, which overlooks Cherokee Park.

Sixty-three Louisville-area designers participated in the project.

Show house hours are Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. (meet the designers 5–8 p.m.); and Sunday, noon to 7 p.m. Doors close 30 minutes before closing times.



The show house will feature a boutique and a cafe, with food prepared by Bristol Catering. Lunch hours are Monday through Saturday, 11 a.m.-2:30 p.m.; and Sunday, 12:30-3:30 p.m. Dinner is served Tuesday and Thursday, 5:30-7:30 p.m.

Tickets at the door are \$12. Buy advance tickets for \$10 at any branch of Stock Yards Bank and Trust Co. or at Cherry House (200 N. Hurstbourne Parkway), Domain Fabric and Interiors (3922 Willis Ave.) or Tassels (12004 Shelbyville Road).
